Economic Development Winnipeg, as the administrator of the Manitoba government's Work in Manitoba job portal, conducted a feedback survey in June and July 2024. Employers and job seekers using the portal were invited to share their insights and suggestions.

Job seekers: Finding job opportunities

83% Easily searched for jobs


77% Applied to a job they matched

Most job seekers (83%) actively use the portal to search for opportunities.

Match notifications are a proven engagement tool, with 77% applying for positions they're matched with.




Active job seekers on the portal

Compared to 2023, more job seekers are applying for matched jobs, rising from 65% to 77%.

In 2024, a similar proportion of job seekers reported being contacted for interviews compared to 2023.





Active employers on the portal


Most employers (70%) have posted one or two job opportunities on the Work in Manitoba job portal.





Employers find the portal straightforward




The majority of employers (86%) found it easy to register and set up their profile on the job portal.
